
## Tips, Tricks, and Did You Knows?

**-Toddler Reading Activity:** As you make lists or write notes, give your child a crayon and paper and let her make a list or write a note, too.


**-Tip:** Let your child see that you can find things to read everywhere. As you go about your day, read cereal boxes, food jars, or stop signs. Point to the words and pictures.
