
Tips, Tricks, and Did You Knows?

-Getting Ready to Read: When your child asks you questions, you may or may not know the answers. Occasionally look for a book that would answer your child's question and say, "Let's find out together."

-Preschool Reading Activity: Pre-school children like to pretend and use their imaginations. Ask your child to "Look like the letter 'Y' or 'C'." Help if he wants you to, or better yet, join in the fun and form the letter "H" together!

-Toddler Reading Activity: Your child can now understand things that cannot be seen. Even if he doesn't understand everything you say, you can talk about concepts and ideas: opposites, spatial position (above, in front of, behind, below), infinity, fairness, and freedom.






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
