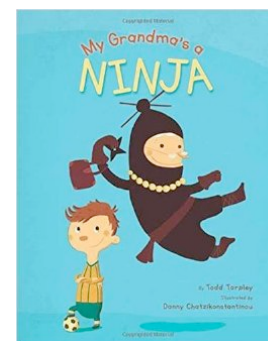
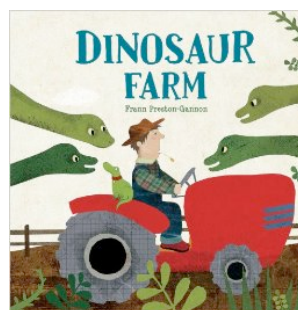
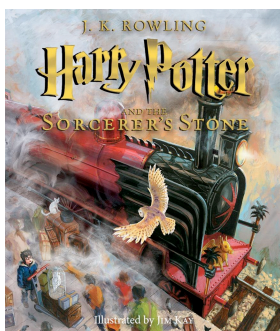


February Picks
